An independent committee of volunteers is now working to revive the famous York Rally, which will return to the Knavesmire on the **20-21st June 2015**. To support this effort cyclists are invited to join the York Rally Sportive, offering a choice of three rides, each supported with marshalls, sag and broom wagons and refreshment stops:

Grande Classic: 140km (87 miles) Taking you to the heart of the North York Moors this will be a rewarding challenge for seasoned riders, including the remarkably steep Rosedale Chimney Bank (an optional bypass route is available).

Classic: 100km (62 miles) Includes challenging climbs, leading to spectacular views in Farndale and around Hutton-le-Hole.

Petit Classic: 36km (22 miles) A flat, well-signed route ideal for families or anyone wanting a gentle ride.
